For teachers

You are the most important role model for presentation and high expectations

- To create consistency in standards of presentation across the school
- To provide a baseline for judging acceptable standards of presentation
- All handwriting which is on display for the children should be joined, legible, consistently formed and neat

Outcomes of Presentation Policy

- Children of all abilities are able to present their work to the highest possible standard increasing their confidence and self esteem
- There is consistency across the school in terms of the standard of the presentation expected
- Progression in presenting work between each year team is evident and understood by all children and adults

Monitoring of the Presentation Policy

- As part of the monitoring cycle of the school members of the Senior Leadership Team will collect examples of children's work on a termly basis to ensure that the policy is being

implemented consistently. This ensures that the policy leads to good practice in facilitating effective feedback, learning and teaching
