<p>WARNING</p> <p>Your behaviour in class may cause your teacher to give you a warning</p>	
<p>LEVEL 1- MOVED IN CLASS</p> <p>If you continue to mis-behave and disturb others, your teacher will move you in class.</p> <p>LOSE 5 MINUTES PLAYTIME</p>	<p>Interrupting learning Not trying Not following instructions Not Polite Off task Lack of respect for equipment</p>
<p>LEVEL 2- SENT TO ANOTHER ADULT</p> <p>If you continue to behave poorly, your teacher will ask you to go to another class in your year team</p> <p>LOSE 10-15 MINUTES PLAY / REFLECTION ROOM</p> <p><i>Reflection Room is recorded & could result in a meeting with parents</i></p>	<p>Lots of <i>level 1</i> behaviour; Lack of respect or rudeness, Just not trying, Damaging equipment</p>
<p>LEVEL 3- SENT TO SLT</p> <p>When moved to another class, your behaviour is still not acceptable. You will be asked to go to the deputy head's classroom.</p> <p>LOSE YOUR NEXT LUNCHTIME</p>	<p>Lots of <i>level 2</i> behaviour; Damaging things (on purpose), Theft (taking things), Bullying, Aggressive use of language towards others, Saying 'NO' Lots of <i>level 2</i> behaviour; Damaging things (on purpose),</p>

	<p>Theft (taking things), Bullying, Aggressive use of language towards others, Saying 'NO'</p>
<p>LEVEL 4- SENT TO HEADTEACHER</p> <p>If you still behave poorly in the Deputy Head's class, you will be asked to go to the Headteacher. He will record this and may ask you to stay for an after school detention.</p> <p>LETTER HOME AND POSSIBLE DETENTION</p>	<p>Lots of <i>level 3</i> behaviour; Threatening or constantly hurting someone (on purpose), Shouting or attacking someone on purpose, Placing others at risk</p>
<p>LEVEL 5- EXCLUSION</p> <p>If your behaviour is so bad, you become un-teachable, you may be excluded from the school.</p> <p>SENT HOME FROM SCHOOL</p>	<p>Ignoring written warning / contract; Being VERY nasty about someone's colour or family Hurting someone badly on purpose</p>
