

Online Safety Agreement

At Sherborne Primary School, we are committed to keeping all children safe when using technology, both in and out of school. This agreement outlines the expectations we have for safe, respectful and responsible online behaviour.

We ask all parents and carers to read and discuss this agreement with their child. By being part of the Sherborne Primary School community, pupils and families are expected to follow these rules to help keep everyone safe online.

For Pupils:

- **I will be responsible for my behaviour when using the internet, including websites, games, apps and social media. This includes the language I use and the content I access.**
- **I will not deliberately search for, download, or share anything that could be considered offensive, upsetting, or illegal. If I see something by accident that makes me uncomfortable, I will tell a trusted adult or a member of school staff straight away.**
- **I will not send messages or share content that could be hurtful, threatening, offensive or inappropriate.**
- **I will keep my personal information private and will not share things like my full name, home address, phone number, or school details online.**
- **I will never share my passwords with anyone else.**
- **If anything I see or receive online makes me feel worried, upset or unsafe, I will speak to an adult I trust—like a teacher or parent.**

For Families:

We encourage all parents and carers to support their child in following these rules. Children's internet use in school is monitored and may be reviewed by school staff to help ensure safety and wellbeing.

These guidelines are designed to help protect all children and promote safe, respectful and enjoyable use of technology. By being part of Sherborne Primary School, pupils and families agree to support and follow this agreement.
